

## **Preparation and practical information for a successful visit to KunstKrakers**

Dear teacher,

We will soon have the pleasure of welcoming you and your class to the KMSKA for the interactive exhibition **KunstKrakers: Discover the Invisible**. During this unique experience, pupils step into the role of art researchers and, using high-tech equipment, uncover the hidden secrets of five artworks from our collection.

### **What is KunstKrakers?**

- The exhibition was developed for children aged 8 to 12, but anyone with a curious and playful mindset can participate. Additional challenges are also available for secondary schools and adults.
- Pupils examine five artworks in small groups using UV lamps, microscopes and scanners. They discover cracks and damage that are invisible to the naked eye.
- Creativity and curiosity are central: by working together, asking questions and thinking outside the box, pupils gradually unravel the artistic mysteries.

### **Practical information**

Duration: approximately 2 hours

Maximum group size: 25 pupils per time slot + 2 supervisors

Organisation: each room contains 5 research tables (maximum 5 pupils per table). Groups have 15 minutes per artwork before moving on to the next room.

### **Preparing for the visit**

Please ensure that you arrive on time with your class. For example, if you have booked for 10 a.m., you are expected to be ready at exactly 10 a.m. at the entrance of the exhibition (first floor). We therefore recommend arriving at least 20 minutes in advance so that you can calmly use the lockers and restrooms.

Divide your class into five groups in advance. A maximum of 5 pupils can work at each table. Try to keep the groups as balanced as possible.

### **What can you expect during the exhibition?**

Pupils are immersed in an engaging storyline and work in small groups on research assignments centred around five different artworks. Each research table provides clear step-by-step instructions. In every room, a screen with a KETNET host guides the groups, gives tips and keeps track of time.
